Visiting the Smithsonian was a common occurrence for him and his family as well as the Museum of Air and Space. Recker comes from a military family and always had aspirations to enlist, first doing so with the United States Air Force at age 18 and going on to become a JTAC (Joint Terminal Attack Controller) Specialist as a part of the U.S. Air Force's Special Forces. Recker's skills were quickly picked up by Foundation Field Agents during the War on Terror in Operation ██████████ where Recker had multiple successful CAS strikes on enemy targets; Field Agents recommended him for induction into the Foundation where he'd be processed into Armed Mobile Task Force Nu-7 "Hammer Down".

Chief Complaint : GSW to the upper right shoulder

[Summary]

Sergeant Recker was brought in after a Nu-7 operation with a complaint of a gunshot wound to the upper right shoulder. Gunshot appears to be of 5.56 NATO caliber and is through and through. No fragments detected on CT scan.

[Treatment]

Sergeant Recker was admitted to surgery to repair a shattered piece of his shoulder as well as his broken shoulder plate. An initial injection of 40mg propofol for the procedure was administered by our anesthesiologist. Shoulder plate was broken in two and surgery involved screwing "connectors" into both plates to hold them together to allow proper healing. Sergeant Recker was discharged from surgery a day later with instructions of rest with avoidance of intense physical activity for the next month. Sergeant Recker will have the connectors removed after 6 months.
