Pastor Samuel R. Johnson II is a 1997 graduate of the United States Coast Guard Academy. He was honorably discharged in 2008, after completing 10 years of dedicated service as a Commissioned Coast Guard Officer. He

received his call to ministry, and was subsequently licensed, in 2002 at Tulane Memorial Baptist Church in Louisiana. As he moved around with the Coast Guard (CG), he served in multiple capacities at multiple churches contributing to youth ministry, dance ministry, preaching, teaching bible studies, and Sunday school. Following his discharge from the CG Pastor Sam received an appointment to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), where he continues to serve as the Deputy Section Chief for the Field Services Section. As he was transitioning from the CG to FEMA in 2008, the Lord led him and his family to join Accokeek First Church of God (AFCOG) under Pastor Daryll Hazard. Over the years at AFCOG, Pastor Sam has preached, taught Sunday school, bible studies, vacation bible school, Bible and leadership class, led march of dimes walks, youth ministry, men's ministry, served on the praise team, as Worship Leader, and as the Vice-Chair for the board of trustees. He completed the Church of God Leadership Focus program in 2019 and received his ministry license from the CHOG in 2020. He holds a Masters in Quality Systems from the National Graduate School and a Masters in Security Studies from the Center for Homeland Defense and Security at the Naval Postgraduate School. He is married to the lovely Tamekia Johnson and they have two beautiful blessings; Mia and Noah Johnson.
