- Teams are to stay out/off of restricted areas listed below:
 - 1. <u>Holes 10-27</u> and the driving range (the center right portions of the golf course to the north)
 - a. Please stay within the front 9, only where the course is located this includes warm up/cooldown
 - 2. Tees, greens, and bunkers
 - 3. Clubhouse and large white tent on the north side of the clubhouse
 - 4. Golf carts
 - 5. Parking Lot other than porta-toilet/food truck area
- No animals of any kind are allowed
- No soccer balls, footballs, frisbees, etc. are allowed
- Restricted areas will be enforced, so please be courteous and respectful.

<u>Scoring/Results</u> - Varsity will be scored with top five athletes from each team. Results will be posted at pttiming and Athletic.net

<u>Concessions/Shirts</u> - Food Trucks will have food/coffee available for purchase. Tier 1 Sports will also be providing custom printed shirts on site, or they can be <u>ordered online in advance here</u>. <u>Online store closes 9/30.</u>

Awards – Medals will be given in the finishing chute to the **Top 10** runners of each race.

<u>Buses</u> - Buses should leave the parking lot after dropping off. There are nearby hotel parking lots across the street, and a Kwik Trip down the street (Rolling Meadows heading east) that are options for parking.
