Paper 1 Reading	Students are expected to answer all exercises that will test their reading and writing abilities.
Question 1 Comprehension and Summary Writing	 Question 1 is based on Text A Comprehension task (based on Text A) Students respond to a series of sub-questions. These sub-questions test understanding of both explicit and implicit meanings and the ability to select/use information from the text. Question 1(f) is based on Text B Summary writing task (based on Text B) Students are asked to summarise a specific part of the text The summary will rely on students being able to pull the correct information from the text and paraphrase it so it is in their own words
Question 2 Comprehension and Writer's Effect	This question requires candidates to respond to Text C. Questions 2 (a-c) Candidates respond to a series of sub-questions that require answers of different lengths. • This question tests their understanding of explicit and implicit meanings and attitudes Question 2 (d) Writer's Effect: Language task • this question requires candidates to respond to Text C. • This question tests their understanding of explicit and implicit meanings and attitudes and how writers achieve effects and influence readers.
Question 3 letter, report, journal, speech, interview and article.	This question requires candidates to respond to Text C. Candidates write about 250–350 words, responding in one of the following text types: letter, report, journal, speech, interview and article. This question tests the following reading assessment objectives understanding of explicit meanings understanding of implicit meanings and attitudes analyse, evaluate, and develop facts, idea,s and opinions, using appropriate support from the text. This question also tests the following writing assessment objectives: articulate experience and express what is thought, felt and imagined organise and structure ideas and opinions for deliberate effect use a range of vocabulary and sentence structures appropriate to the context

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use register appropriate to the context.
