Subject: Statement on the passing of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II of the United Kingdom and others

To the People of Fremont, Greetings:

SALT LAKE CITY, UTAH— I was extremely saddened to hear of the passing of the sovereign of the United Kingdom, of Canada, of Australia, and others, Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II. Her Majesty is the longest reigning monarch in British history and the second longest reigning monarch in human history. Her reign has been marked with consistent bravery, dignity, valor, and compassion, as she worked forever the better the lives of her people wherever they were.

Her Majesty dedicated her life, from a young age, to the service of her people, even when served in the forces of her father, King George VI, during the Second World War.
