

CREATIVE WORKSHOP

Based on the song "Morgen" by Ivo Robić

These workshops explore language, meaning, and visual communication using one Croatian and one German verse and chorus of the song. All workshops end with a printed design on a canvas tote bag.

WORKSHOP 1: BLACK-OUT POETRY

Goal: Create a new message by selecting and hiding words from the original song text.

Materials:

- Printed song text (Croatian + German)
- Black markers (thick)
- One light-colored marker (optional)

Instructions

1. Read the text carefully.
2. Circle words or phrases you want to keep.
3. Black out all other words using a marker.
4. Your final text should be short and clear (1–3 lines).
5. You may mix Croatian and German words.

Rules

- Do not add new words.
- Focus on meaning, not grammar perfection.

Friendship

Travel and meeting others

Your black-out poem will be scanned or photographed and printed in black and white.

WORKSHOP 2: STREET SYMBOLS (Visual Language of Morgen)

Goal: Translate words and ideas from the song into simple visual symbols that work without language.

Materials

- Paper sheets
- Thick black markers
- 1 additional color marker (optional)

Instructions

1. Choose ONE word or idea from the song (e.g. tomorrow, journey, sun, hope).
2. Choose ONE or TWO symbols from the Symbol Bank or create a similar one.
3. Draw your symbol clearly using thick lines.
4. Keep it bold and simple.

Rules

- Maximum 2 colors
- No small details
- No scissors, no cutting
- No sentences (one word only if really needed)

Tote Bag Print

Your symbol will be printed large and centered, or repeated as a pattern.

WORKSHOP 3: ERASMUS SLOGAN (Tomorrow Starts Today)

Goal: Create a short slogan inspired by the song that could work as Erasmus merchandise.

Materials

- Paper
- Markers

Instructions

1. Create a slogan with 3–5 words.
2. You may mix languages (English / German / Croatian).
3. Choose one simple graphic sign (line, arrow, dot).
4. Arrange the text clearly.

Examples

- Tomorrow starts today
- Morgen starts heute
- Together for tomorrow

Rules

Keep it minimal

One idea only

Clean typographic print with a simple symbol.

SYMBOL BANK – VISUAL LANGUAGE OF “MORGEN / TOMORROW”

NOTE: These symbols are shown in *DRAWABLE* form so they work on every computer and printer. Students should **COPY** the *SHAPE*, not the font.

RULE: If you can draw it in 10 seconds with a thick marker, it's a good symbol.

ARROW

Shape example: □ / ^

Meaning: Future, tomorrow, movement

HORIZON / LINE

Shape example: _____

Meaning: Path, journey, beginning

PARALLEL LINES

Shape example: || ||

Meaning: Connection, travelling together

SUN / HALF SUN

Shape example: () (⌋)

Meaning: Morning, hope, new start

CIRCLE

Shape example: O

Meaning: World, unity

DOT

Shape example: .

Meaning: Now, moment

TWO LINES MEETING

Shape example: ^

Meaning: Meeting, friendship

OPEN SHAPE / DOOR

Shape example: [

Meaning: Opportunity, openness

WAVE LINE

Shape example: ~ ~ ~

Meaning: Music, rhythm, emotion

RISING LINE

Shape example: /

Meaning: Growth, positive future

COMBINATIONS (max 2 symbols):

- . + -> = now → future
- () + _____ = morning is coming
- ^ + O = people together in one world

DESIGN TIPS:

- Bold lines only
- Maximum 2 colors
- No decoration, no small details
- Black works best for printing on tote bags
