Abstract: Abstracts are written in English, reflecting a general description of the research or article content. The abstract contains: research problems and objectives, research methods, research results and conclusions. The abstract is written in the form of 1 paragraph, written in Indonesian and English and, 11 pt Cambrian letters, 150-250 words, with 1 space between lines, and spacing after 0 Pt.

Title in Indonesia

Abstrak: *The abstract is written in Indonesian and should provide a general overview of the research or article content. It must include the research problem and objectives, research methods, findings, and conclusions. The abstract should be written in one paragraph, in both Indonesian and English, using Cambria 11 pt font, with a word count of 150-250 words, single line spacing, and 0 pt spacing after paragraphs.*

INTRODUCTION (Cambria 12 Pt, Bold)

The full-text article should be written in either Indonesian or English and submitted in Word format. The introduction must be written in Cambria 12 Pt font, with 1.5 line spacing and 0 pt spacing after paragraphs. The total length of the article should be 10-15 pages. A detailed explanation of the background of the problem, emphasizing why the research needs to be conducted.

1) State of the art (a brief literature review) referring to journal articles or research findings from the last 10 years.

2) An explanation of the novelty of the study compared to previous research.



- 3) The contribution to the development of scientific knowledge in the relevant field.
- 4) The expected results or research objectives outlined in the article.

The introduction should be written in a narrative format within paragraphs, without subheadings. Ensure that you have conducted a plagiarism check (with a similarity index of less than 20%). The plagiarism check report can be attached as a Supplementary File. Citations should follow this format: (Dahlia, 2019).

RESEARCH METHOD (Cambria 12 Pt, Bold)

This section explains the research method used in the study. It should clearly describe the research approach, including details related to the population size or sample, sampling techniques, data collection methods, and data analysis techniques employed. However, it should not focus extensively on theoretical discussions (Cambria 12 Pt, 1,5 Spasi dan *spacing after 0 Pt*).

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION (Cambria 12 Pt, Bold)

This section presents the latest research findings, emphasizing novelty (originality) and demonstrating the development of the studied discipline by discussing them in relation to previous studies. It should highlight the study's contribution to knowledge and include comparisons with prior research results (Cambria 12 Pt, 1,5 Spasi dan *spacing after 0 Pt*)

1. Images, maps, and photos must be clear.
2. The size of images, graphs, tables, etc., should be adjusted to fit the paper size.

CONCLUSION (Cambria 12 Pt, Bold)

The conclusion must be written clearly, concisely, and comprehensively, directly addressing the research problem stated in the abstract. It should be presented in paragraph form (not as bullet points). The first paragraph should discuss the conclusions and implications of the research findings, while the second paragraph should outline future research directions and highlight the limitations of the study (Cambria 12 Pt, 1,5 Spasi dan *spacing after 0 Pt*)

ACKNOWLEDGMENT (if applicable)

Include the parties involved in your research, especially those who provided financial support for your study (such as supervisors, funding agencies, or other contributors).

REFERENCES (Cambria 12 Pt, Bold)

- 1) For citation management, it is recommended to use software such as Mendeley, EndNote, or similar programs. We strongly encourage authors to cite journal articles (rather than other sources) whenever possible.
- 2) A minimum of 25 references is required (starting from the August 2023 edition). References should be from international or national journal articles or books, with a maximum publication age of 10 years, except for historical materials used as classical sources published more than 10 years ago. At least 80% of the total references must be primary sources (scholarly journals).
- 3) Only references cited within the text should be included
