SAT 2026

This year Duxbury High School will offer the SAT on Monday, April 20th, 2026. Registration will be conducted through Duxbury High School Guidance. There is a **deadline of Wednesday, April 1st** for students to submit the registration form and payment to the Guidance Office, students will be registered on a first come first serve basis. The cost of the exam is \$80. Payment may be made in the form of cash or check made out to Duxbury High School.

All students taking the SAT will need to take it digitally this year. Students will have the technology set up on their school issued chromebooks and will need to use these on testing day.

SAT Fast Facts:

When: Monday, April 20th, 2026 at 8 am (the test starts at 8am so students should report to the high school by 7:45am)
Please note that this is the only test date Duxbury High School will offer for the SAT. Please note that this date is during April vacation and refunds will not be available after exams are ordered.

Where: Duxbury High School-room assignments will be published closer to the test date

SAT Overview

There are 2 hours and 15 minutes of actual testing time. Time for short breaks and test administration tasks is additional. Most students in the standard time rooms will be here from 8am until 10:30am. Rooms move at different paces so times are only approximate.
