Follow the steps below to run for Student Council!

Step 1: Decide What You're Running For	<p>Executive Elections (Thursday, May 19):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Student Body President (must be current member of council)• Student Body V.P. (must be current member of council)• Student Body Secretary (must be current member of council)• Student Body Treasurer (must be current member of council)• Class President (10th, 11th, & 12th Grades) <p>General Elections (Thursday, May 26):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• All class representative positions (Grades 9-12) <p>*Note that class vice president, class secretary, and class treasurer, along with other cabinet positions, will be determined later by council. All elected reps are eligible for these positions.</p>
Step 2: Apply to Run for Council	<p>EXECUTIVE ELECTION (DEADLINE MONDAY, MAY 16)</p> <p>If you are applying to run for an Executive Position, find the application here.</p> <p>GENERAL ELECTION (DEADLINE MONDAY, MAY 23)</p> <p>If you are applying to run in the General Election, find the application here.</p>
Step 3: Read the Campaign Rules and Expectations	<p>Read the rules carefully.</p> <p>Upload your one-pager to the Google Drive folder here.</p> <p>Email Mr. Schilt (aschilt@chelsea.k12.mi.us) or Ms. Helberg (mhelberg@chelsea.k12.mi.us) if you have questions.</p>
