Policy:

The district will display in each facility of learning, in a prominent manner, achieving maximum visibility, the following documents:

1. The Declaration of Independence
2. The Constitution
3. The Bill of Rights
4. The Ten Commandments

These documents shall be displayed under the heading: “Morality and virtue, the foundation of Freedom and Liberty”

Upon completion of the installation in the 2026/27 school year, the administrators of each facility shall commemorate the display, in a respectful manner, including the student body as seen fit. The commemoration shall be memorized and retained for future promotion and publication purposes as appropriate.

The director of schools shall be responsible for coordinating the design of the display with appropriate parties and present the design for board approval.

As determined by administrators, future commemorations are encouraged. They shall be conducted in a respectful manner, with student body participation included as administrators see fit. The activities shall be memorialized and retain the activities for future promotion and purposes as appropriate.

During the year of 2076, memorialized activities shall be used to support public and institutional recognition of America’s tricentennial anniversary of independence. At minimum, the district will creatively and appropriately display, in a respectful manner, the memorialized activities that occurred over the fifty-year time period from 2026 through 2076.
