	Is there <u>evidence</u> the students are following established routines and procedures that help the class run smoothly?	
	Are the transitions between activities or subjects smooth and quick?	
	Are behavior expectations consistently and fairly reinforced by the teacher?	
	Is misbehavior addressed promptly, calmly, and respectfully by the teacher?	
	Is there <u>evidence</u> the teacher is using proactive strategies, such as proximity or non-verbal cues, to minimize disruptions?
