Name of nation: Joronun Monarchy/Joronun Nexus

Brief description of society:

A monarchy where the Queen does hold absolute power, but rarely exercises it. There are elected officials and a parliament where common folk do cast votes. Industry is divided equally into private and governmental sectors. However, all production info and gross input and output finds its way to the Supervisor(Ossiesi). The military answers to the Queen and the General(Hesseder). Research and philosophy dominate the education system, with these specifications in high demand. Any other things, agriculture, policing, diplomacy, to name a few, all fall to a group called the Vasteykyir.

There are also four castes and mobility between them. At the top, the Royals. The Queen and her direct compatriots. Below that is the Third Circuit, consisting of the Hesseder, and the Ossiesi and all related to them. Below that is the Second Circuit, where the Vasteykyir Council and most common Joronun. The First Circuit is comprised of the remainder of Joronun that either wish to live without the Queen, or simply live on their own.

Species

Name of species: Joronun Kani

Brief description of species:

Insectoid, humanoid creatures. A Joronun is around 1.5-2.5 meters tall and weigh 250 lbs maximum. Their hands are three fingered and end in sharp points. They do not "see", but instead rely on vibrations and highly precise hearing. Their hearing organs are masses of quills that can either run along the sides of their heads, or act as a mane/hair. Their vibratory organs are a large, spur like growth that runs the length of their calf. The organs are nodules filled with a gelatin like substance, with muscle fibers running the length of the nodule. The outer exoskeleton of a Joronun breaks down lightly in the presence of too much UV radiation.

Joronun were a prey species, owing to many of Kanathons numerous predator species. The main predator species they have dealt with and still deal with rarely are a species of parasitic moths, named the Vosnekai.

A Joronun looks humanoid in shape and generally has a more hunched over posture. Their exoskeleton is present over areas of soft tissue. The mouth appears to shut and close like a person interlocking their fingers. They have no visible eyes, but slits where eyes would be. Joronun range in color from pale white to hot pink. Queens have several differences in physiology. They have wing plates present on their backs, but no functioning wings, actual eyes, thinner listening quills (more akin to wiry hair).

The Royals share all the same features, save the hunched posture and lack of eyes. They do sport more Aeginian like eyes and patterns on their exoskeleton. Queens generally have one defining feature, be it enhanced strength, higher intelligence or a mutation.

While normal Joronun live for 400-500 years a Queen's lifespan is generally unknown as it seems to vary with each Queen, but the average is around 800. The maximum lifespan for a Queen was recorded at 1,220 years.

Planetary System

Name(s) of star(s): Euizal

List of planets:

- Kanathon
- Attakon, a frozen wasteland bearing only icy spires, vast canyons and high winds.
- Halmnk, a scorching desert planet where clouds are as rare as water is on Kanathon. A completely dead planet.

Brief description of primary planet(s):

Kanathon is a horrid place. Thick and choking atmosphere, oceans comprised of oil, towering stony outcrops that are as sharp as blades, dangerous wildlife and a lack of water make it a terrible place to live. Attakon and Halmnk have no habitation whatsoever. Their environments are far too hostile for the Joronun to succeed against, at the moment.

However horrid Kanathon is, it is a strangely beautiful planet with diverse jungles, beautiful lowlands and shining deserts.

List of primary planet's moons:

- Kanathons moons- Amlert, a simple, rocky moon. Sskau, a swampy moon, teeming with animals, water and life. A place loved by the Joronun
- Halmnks moon- Baque, a strange primordial planet where life has started anew. This moon is off limits to the Joronun, by the Queen's orders.

Miscellaneous

Life on Kanathon:

Life on Kanathon has a unique situation. In some places plant life has had to adapt and evolve with no water. This has lead to what the Drell call, Plastoid Plants. These are highly inedible but are extremely useful. The Adrok plastoid is a great example. It has thin fibers that become rigid under an electric current. While in other places, water is available, the plants have adapted to deal without much water. Regardless, life is extremely exotic on Kanathon.

Other important notes:

Hold a Remnant Relic, The Unmaker. It is a spherical object around the size of a baseball with a dull green soapstone color. It has grooves and etchings, indicating that it could possibly be opened. It can absorb energy from Xanafian shards and convert it into "Unmaker" energy. It's actual use has rarely been used, but terrifying in prospect. When used on a living creature, it will break the creature down to its base components. After

this happens, the Unmaker can then build the creature back up, as the wielder sees fit.

And while they are semi-isolationist, they hold a festival all species are welcome to enjoy, the Glisten Days Festival. Where water flows free, candy, masks and fun abound!

Rumored Birthplace:

The birthplace of the Joronun is only talked about in the oldest of their fairytales and myths. The fairytales speak of a place of glimmering sand and the most beautiful flowers. Where darkness had never been known. The Glisten. A place of beauty and warmth. Yet, it is only a fairytale. You'll find some scholars who know the old stories, but for the most part it is forgotten.
