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CV MEDICAL BUILDING, UPDATE- the owners of the CV Medical Building, **Khal Chassidim of WPB**, has resubmitted an application to convert part of that building into a Religious Place of Worship, reduce existing parking, and to construct two swimming pools at the rear and side of this building. Specifically, the application requests ***“to reduce the number of parking spaces; reduce the side and rear setbacks; and, to eliminate a Compatibility Buffer to reconfigure the site plan and modify the Conditions of Approval.”*** The application number is **ZV/DOA-2021-02186**; the Notice Of Application is appended to this report.

This application will be reviewed by the PBC Zoning Commission (**11/3**) and the Palm Beach County Commissioners (**11/28**) during the month of November. Century Village unit owners are strongly encouraged to attend these important meetings. To make attendance at these meetings easier, UCO will provide bus service to and from both of these meetings. Commissioner Weiss has already responded to a number of inquiries from CV unit owners about this application, and has asked that his response be published for all CV unit owners:

“With regard to the application (ZV/DOA-2021-02186), I want to make sure your comments are heard by the right people. Please allow me a minute to explain. This zoning application consists of two distinctly different requests, and these different requests will be decided by different ‘bodies’. There are requests for variances, and there is a request to make changes to the development order, called Development Order Amendments:

1. REQUEST FOR VARIANCES / DECISION BY THE PBC ZONING

COMMISSION: *The request for variances will be decided by the PBC Zoning Commission, which is an advisory board made up of 9 people (see Donald’s article for their email addresses). The Zoning Commission will meet to decide on this application on **November 3, 2022 at 9:00 A.M. in the Vista Center located at 2300 N Jog Rd.** If you have concerns about the variances, you should email the Zoning Commissioners, as they are the ones making the decisions on the variances. The applicant has requested Type 2 Variances relating to parking, setback and landscape buffer requirements.*

2. REQUEST TO AMEND DEVELOPMENT ORDER / DECISION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS: *The other part of this application requests to make changes to the development order. These are called **Development Order Amendments**. Here, the Zoning Commission makes a recommendation to the Board of County Commissioners, and the Board of County Commissioners makes the final decision. The Board of County Commissioners will meet to decide on this application on **November 28, 2022 at 9:30 A.M. at the Governmental Center located at 301 N Olive Ave in West Palm Beach**. The applicant has requested a Development Order Amendment to:*

- *Amend conditions of approval and reconfigure the Site Plan.*
- *Approve revisions will include allowing the uses to be reconfigured within the same building footprint to eliminate the Adult Day Care and allow a Place of Worship.*

Regarding requests relating to a place of worship, there are strict guidelines and protections by federal law that protect places of worship from unduly burdensome or discriminatory land use Regulations.
