PHS Course Outline - Spanish 5

<u>Course Overview:</u> This class is structured to emphasize all four aspects of language learning: reading, writing, speaking, listening with heavy emphasis on meaningful communication through an immersive and interactive environment. This class will be conducted 90% of the time in the target language, focusing on language acquisition by means of comprehensible input.
