Eligibility

Students must be conducting research in systems and networking research pertaining to cloud, edge and Internet-of Things (IoT), as well as technologies for intelligent computing, learning, Big Data and blockchain applications and be in good standing or up to 6 months after graduating with their doctoral degree.

Supervisor Recommendation Letter:

- Ensure your name and email address are included in the recommendation letter
- Limit 1 page
- The recommendation letter must be sent by the supervisor. The file name should be {PhD_student_lastname}_recommendation.pdf

A two-page extended abstract that summarizes

- The main research areas or difficulties the applicant is focusing on, such as a potential thesis subject.
- The notable contributions made towards their research focus.
- The directions for the remaining work.
