

Stefanie Dobrin graduated from Highland Park High School, where she ran Cross Country and Track and Field all 4 years. She walked on the Track and Field team at Indiana University as a 300 hurdler and realized that it was not a good fit. For her student teaching, she helped coach the Easterne Greene High School Track and Field team and found her love for coaching. Stefanie started her coaching career at Marshall High School coaching track and field for 15 years and cross country for 5 years at Whitney Young.



Currently, Stefanie is the Head Boys and Girls Cross Country and Track and Field coach at Lincoln Park High School. She just finished her 3rd year coaching Cross Country and about to start her 5th year of Track and Field. In 16 out of her 19 previous years, she has had 22 qualifiers and 1 All-State athlete at the Illinois State Track and Field meet.

Stefanie also coaches the Windy City Hammers Track Club, a USATF youth club. For the 10 years of coaching at the club level, she has had multiple All-Americans as well as 2 National Champion relays from this past summer. Our 17-18 women for the 4x100 and 4x400 relays were the National Champions.

She is a Level 1 USATF coach and received her Level 2 USATF coaching in Endurance, Jumps, Sprints, Hurdles and Relays.
