Yuri

Something that's very characteristic of Yuri is her unpredictability. She is one of only two characters in this entire sim with a 1 in loyalty and temperament. This will cause her to be all over the place, both strategically and socially. She does counter this somewhat by having a maxed out strategic skill and acceptable social skills, but in the end I don't see the other players being willing to put up with her for very long. Her comp skills aren't great, so I can definitely see her being a pawn early on as well.

Sokka has extremely strong stats across the board with very few exploitable weaknesses... which isn't always a good thing. I feel like there's an unseen 8th stat in these games, which is, a characters threat level. As the player does things in the game, physically/strategically/socially, the other players *react* to that by seeing them as more of a threat. In any case, I don't think Sokka will have a hard time early on unless he gets extremely unlucky with who wins HoH.

Hermione has very similar stats to Sokka, and as a result, has many of the same flaws he has. I do have a little more faith in Hermione however, as she's less threatening physically and slightly stronger socially. But her social game is still only average, and I don't think it will make enough of a difference for her to survive being targeted later on in the game.

The Queen is definitely going to shine in this house socially. And with high strategic skill, I expect her to be one of the people making alliances early on. That should be enough for her to survive the early game since I doubt she'll win any comps or be perceived as a threat. But I really don't see her making it to the end with her comp stats being so low. She wouldn't be the first person in the history of SimBB to make it that far without winning comps, but she'd need to be really smart/lucky with who she allies and it's not normally how seasons roll out.

The Rock

You'd think the Rock's game would center around winning competitions, but you'd be wrong. This guy is going to be built more towards building social bonds in the House. The low temper score might interfere with this, but I don't think it'll be enough to send him packing early on. The low loyalty also means he'll be moving fluidly throughout the house, which should allow his social game to shine more brightly. All and all, I feel very good about the Rock's chances, but there are others who I think are in a better position to be taken deep into the endgame.

Out of everyone we've seen so far, Kim has the best and most consistent competition stats. Normally this would worry me, as it'd make me think she'd be seen as a threat, but as we'll see soon, there are MANY others who overshadow her in this area. Because of this, I'm very optimistic about Kim's chances. The good temperament score also leads me to believe Kim will avoid the drama early on like the plague, which is generally a good idea. Compared to everyone else in the cast, I can see Kim making it to the Final 2.

Similarly to Kim, Bean has mostly well-balanced stats in just about every area. Most of what I said about Kim also applies to this bean, however, he does have one critical flaw that I think could sink his chances. Trading a point in temperament for a point in the Physical stat usually isn't worth it in my opinion, and having a maxed out stat could worry some of the others in the house, especially if he doesn't pull out any early wins. His stats are still good, so I'm giving him a high estimation, but I don't have him in my Final 2.

Yuuji, what the fuck? Did you not just see me praise 2 characters for having balanced stats? *sigh* Yuuji is going to win a few competitions, so I'd pay close attention to his social game (how little of it there is) to see what his decisions may be leaning towards before his inevitable early eviction. It's not even that his strategic/social stats are particularly bad, it's just that his comp stats are totally maxed out and everyone in that house is going to see him as a threat. What's more, with a loyalty score of 1, nobody with half a brain is going to trust him long-term.

I'm gonna start off by saying that I think Evan's placement in this game is going to be pretty telling. He has some pretty solid comp stats but nothing that'll make him stand out early on. And on top of this he also has a good strategic score. It should be enough for him to get through 1 or 2 weeks. But I don't think he's going to be able to overcome that bad social game in this house. Evan does have the benefit of there

being a few more threatening players that also have bad social games, but I don't think it'll be enough to save him from an early boot.

Travis is in the same vein as Kim and Bean in terms of his stats. In fact, if you looked at the 3 side-by-side, you'd find very little significant differences. I do think both Bean and Kim have the edge in this competition though, as Travis' slightly higher comp skills will likely cause him to be targeted before either of them. Luckily, he doesn't have many other exploitable weaknesses and I expect that we'll be seeing him in this house for awhile.

I think Fry might be seen as one of the least threatening people in the house, and that shouldn't be underestimated. Average physical stats could be enough to win the game as long as he excels in the other areas, and that high loyalty should keep him well protected early on. My biggest concern with him is that 2 for Strategic skill. I can't remember the last time a SimBB winner had a strategic score below a 3, if ever. I see him as a middle of the road kind of boot.

A player with these stats and a 1 in loyalty could cause some serious havoc in the game while still having a shot at winning. Alas, we get Cadence, who probably won't make any waves, and we'll be left questioning if she was even a player on the season. I'm just gonna predict she goes Pre-Jury because that's what I'm hoping for.

Wolf's stats are passable for the most part. I definitely believe he'll be seen as a threat more so than the likes of Kim/Bean/Travis, but he doesn't lean as far in one direction as Yuuji either. His low social stats don't bode well for him lasting long in any case, but he does perform better in this area than someone like Evan. What separates him from typical BB villains is that he doesn't have a particularly strong strategic game either. I think there are others who will go before him, but he could see the block multiple times.

We've looked at a ton of players that are very strong physically, and many who have balanced stats across the board, but only one other character here shares a similar layout to Bubblegum. Queen Elizabeth. I expect we may see these 2 work together, and if that's the case, the sky's the limit. It's hard to picture a scenario where Bubblegum gets nominated and evicted against just about anyone else here. Because of all that, I wouldn't be surprised to see this princess in the Final 2.

The only way I see Phi going home early is if she really struggles with the social game, otherwise, I think she's non-threatening enough to slip under the radar for everyone in the house. However, I don't think she'll have strong enough bonds with the other houseguests to be taken to the end, and not all the competitions are going to benefit her stat layout.
