



1 Split for how the surveys were completed (digital or print)




2 Split for postcode sectors




3 How many years have you lived in this area




4 Which age bracket do you fall into?




5 Number of adults in the household?




6 Number of people under the age of 18




7 Do you consider yourself to have a physical disability?




8 What is your gender?

521 responded to this question. Of the responses given, key phrases emerging included:


- "[Better quality] shops" mentioned 149 times
















