# **BRNI Selection Criteria – 2025**

# <u>Ultimate criteria for full package — our final evaluation before finalizing proposals</u>

- Must work within GEDCO's timeframe/capacity. (This hasn't been an issue, but it recognizes that GEDCO is technically the applicant for these funds and has historically done a lot of work to get the requests submitted. We try to pay attention to GEDCO's needs in this process.)
- Ideally would be a mix of commercial and residential.

#### <u>Threshold Criteria for Each Proposal – must be met</u>

- Must advance/implement the 2019 BRNI plan, with specific step or steps in the plan cited.
- Project must be in York Road BRNI area boundary (<u>purple areas here</u>).
- Project lead must be clear and known.

## Scoring Rubric - Up to 30 Points Total

#### • Capacity of Applicant — 10 points

- 6 points: How successful of a track record does the project team have on this type of project or similar projects?
- o 4 points: Does the project team have the capacity to manage the project and the grant?

#### • Impact — 10 points

- o 5 points: How soon are we likely to see short-term results? Is it "shovel ready"?
- 5 points: How far do we think this will advance our BRNI plan relative to the resources spent on it?

## • Financial Plan — 10 points

- o 5 points: Is budget clear and appropriate to reach goals?
- o 5 points: How much of the rest of the funding in the budget is already in-hand or committed?
- (-3 points): Are there other sources of funding in the budget that are especially speculative?
