CHARLOTTE HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

Charlotte County Public Schools believes that extracurricular activities play a vital role in enriching our students' high school experience by fostering teamwork, developing leadership skills, and building lasting memories. We strongly encourage all students to "get involved and stay involved" by exploring interests through the many opportunities available at Charlotte High School.

However, participation in these valuable extra-curricular activities is a privilege that comes with responsibilities. Just as Charlotte County Public Schools emphasizes the fundamental importance of consistent daily attendance for academic success, Charlotte High School requires that students maintain good standing in THREE key areas to be eligible for participation in extra-curriculars.

Requirements:

Attendance

• Absences may not exceed 20% of lost instructional time per period

Academics

- At least a 2.0 unweighted GPA
- Passing all core classes needed for graduation *If less than a 2.0 weighted GPA, current grades need to be 69.5% (equivalent to 2.0)
- No more than one class needed for credit recovery

Discipline

• No zero-tolerance referrals, and no repeat OSS/ISS infractions

Extracurricular activities/privileges include, but are not limited to:

- Participating in athletics
- Participating in co-curriculars (Band, NJROTC, Theatre)
- Participating in clubs
- Participating in OJT
- Attending Homecoming and Prom
- Utilizing parking privileges on campus
- Maintaining driver's license (risk of revocation by DMV)
- Attending events at school (athletics/productions/concerts)

Charlotte High School has high expectations and believes prevention is key. If a student fails to meet one of the above requirements, a parent/guardian may reach out to request a meeting with our Assistant Principal in charge of activities to develop an improvement plan to help a student get back on track.
