How to Connect a Non-Smart TV

A Non-Smart TV can give you similar benefits when connected to the Internet. You can do this by connecting wifi to your TV. Let's see some ways.

Here is the general process of connecting the device to your TV.

- *Find the HDMI port on your TV, then connect the gadget there.
- *Connect the USB port on both devices.
- *Turn on the TV and connect.
- *Download any necessary apps.
- *Agree to all of the terms and conditions of the downloaded apps.
- *Start streaming.

Another way is a connection through an HDMI cable. Your Tv can be connected to the Internet through this cable. You connect to a PC, laptop or Smartphone.

Make sure your TV has an HDMI connector and that your laptop or PC has a video out. Follow the process below.

- *Switch off your TV and laptop.

You can also opt for using a Blu-ray disc. Blu-ray is a type of digital optical disc. They serve as data storage devices, having been first created to replace DVD players.

They provide higher-quality audio and video than streaming devices. Only an HDMI cable is required to connect your Blu-ray disc to your TV.

*Use your remote to input your Wifi password.
