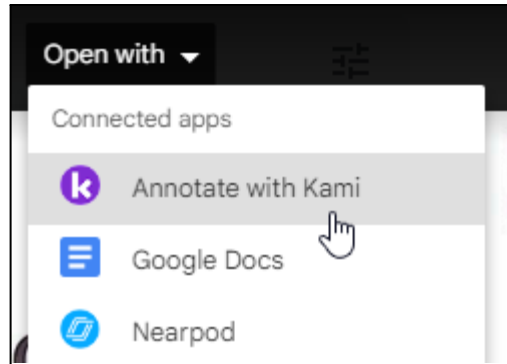

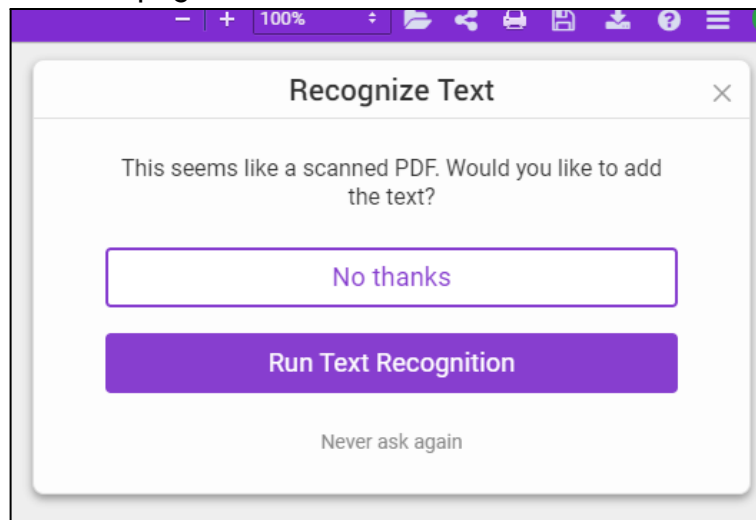
Recognizing Text from a Scanned PDF

Option 1: Kami

Upload the scanned PDF into Google Drive then tell it to **Open with** → **Annotate with Kami**.

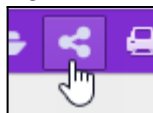


Once in Kami, a box to Recognize Text should pop up. Select **Run Text Recognition**. It will display a progress bar at the bottom of the page as it converts.



The teacher needs to check the document to make sure it is converted. They can use Kami tools to make notes about anything that didn't convert well.

Use Kami's **Share** options to share the text recognized file.

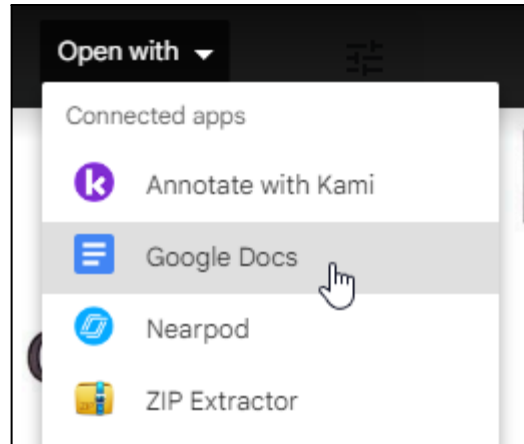

Recognizing Text from a Scanned PDF

Option 2: Google Docs

Upload the scanned PDF into Google then tell it to **Open with** → **Google Docs**.



Users will need to clean up the new Google Doc file (clear formatting, remove extra characters and spacing, etc.) since it converts some things a little weird but it works for most of the conversion.
