The analyst will be fully embedded on the Boann Communications & Reporting team. The analyst will have the opportunity to lead a variety of projects, based on their expertise, interest and a discussion with the Manager. Projects may include:

- Support the development of Boann's communications guide.
- Create a Boann award focused on recognizing excellence in impact in the sector.
- Design a webinar series plan focused on highlighting innovative efforts, equity-deserving communities, emerging themes, and Boann expertise in the sector.
- Contribute to developing communications products as they arise, including web updates, social media, newsletters, press releases, articles, graphics, etc.
- Highlight successes of Boann's investees through a storytelling approach via relevant platforms.
- Support Boann team members in developing and publishing thought leadership articles on emerging and critical subjects in the sector.
- Work collaboratively with Boann's Impact Measurement Specialist to begin preparing the 2025 Impact Report.
