



RHS SATURDAY SCHOOL Spring 2024

Romeo High School Students (10th-12th grade),

Over the last few weeks, we have had a steady increase of absences and late/missing work. To help ensure everyone keeps up on their attendance and assignments, we will be reinstituting Saturday School for 10th, 11th, and 12th grade students starting next week (first Saturday School will be April 13th).

Please know, if you come to school every day and get your work turned in one time (like you're supposed to) then this will have ZERO effect on you.

Saturday School will be similar to a detention, but for attendance/academic reasons (instead of discipline). Teachers may assign Saturday School for any students who:

- Needs to make up a summative (without a legitimate reason for missing school the day of the summative)
- Did not get his/her missing assignments submitted on time (per the grading policy, you have one day per day absent to submit missing work)
- Has to redo an assignment due to cheating/plagiarism (this will be determined by your teacher)
- Is behind and has late assignments that need to be made up (this will be determined by your teacher)

If assigned a Saturday School, your teacher will speak with you and set the date. An email follow-up to you and your parents will also be sent so there isn't any confusion. If you are assigned a Saturday School, **DO NOT FORGET, SKIP, OR BE LATE**. Any of the following will result in you not being able to make up the assignment; thus a ZERO for a grade:

- Skipping or forgetting to show up
- Arriving late. Saturday School begins promptly at 8:00 AM and **you must arrive by 7:55 or earlier** (doors will be locked at 7:55 and no one will be admitted afterwards). If you are late, it will be considered skipping Saturday School

Saturday School Details:

- When: 8:00 -10:00 AM on Saturdays (April 22-May 20). Doors locked at 7:55 AM
- Where: RHS Commons
- Proctors: RHS principals and teachers
