Under the direction of the Managing Director of Program, the Program Manager Consultant will be responsible for supporting the implementation of ABC's continuous special education school improvement model in partner districts and schools. This position is an excellent opportunity to join a dedicated and collaborative team in a growing nonprofit committed to transforming how students with disabilities are served in schools and districts.

We're seeking a consultant (or several) who can work either (1) on an hourly basis for between 10-20 hours a week for approximately six months or (2) on a project basis who can dedicate the hours necessary to complete the desired scope in the timeline needed. The pay rate for this role is \$50-65/hour. All pre-approved travel and work-related expenses will be reimbursed.

Responsibilities: The Program Manager will:

- Support school and district partners to build their knowledge of ABC's Special Education Framework for Quality and suite of continuous improvement services
- Develop high-quality professional learning experiences for partner educators and stakeholders
- Produce and present clear and concise written communications and practice tools for classroom, school, and district implementation
- Draft project status reports, data dashboards, meeting minutes, action item logs, etc.
