***HRRMC Foundation Scholarships*** There are multiple opportunities for high school students looking to begin college with a scholarship supporting a healthcare career or college students working to continue their efforts in healthcare education. Apply [here](#). Deadline: March 21, 2025 (local)

***Cecilia A Williams Memorial Music Scholarship*** Eligibility requirements: Salida High School Graduating Senior; Pursue career in Music; Minimum GPA- 3.0. All application materials due to the SHS Counseling Department by May 1. Application linked [here](#).

***Epsilon Sigma Alpha/Alpha Omicron Chapter Scholarships*** Eligibility: students who are entering a business school, trade school, college or university in fall of 2025; GPA of 'C' (2.0) or better; Complete all parts of application and submit by April 15.
