2025-2026 The Faculty Center Outstanding Scholarly Publication Awards Guidelines

Description: The Faculty Center will present **two** Outstanding Scholarly Publication Awards: one in a STEM-related field, and one in social sciences or humanities. The scholarly publication can be in either a discipline-specific area of research or in the area of the scholarship of teaching and learning. These awards will honor the best original scholarly publications by a member of the Farmingdale State College faculty or professional staff; the winners will receive \$1,000 each, funded by the Farmingdale College Foundation.

Eligibility: Nominees must have a full-time appointment at Farmingdale State College and must be employed by the College when the work is published and while the selection process is in progress.

Types of Publications: Books, monographs, chapters, journal articles, published conference proceedings and edited works which were published between **January 1, 2023 – December 31, 2025** are eligible. Reprints of oral presentations are excluded.

Each nominee may be considered for only one published work. A nominee may not submit multiple published works under one nomination form, nor may they submit multiple nomination forms.

If multiple authors on the publication are employees who meet the eligibility criteria, the prize may be split among them.

Nominating Procedure:

- A nomination requires submission of the Outstanding Scholarly Publication Award Nomination Form, the statement of importance and any other supporting materials, and the complete text of the publication, **preferably combined into 1 PDF, by December 19th, 2025.**
- If the work is a book, a hard copy can be dropped off to Jennifer Jaiswal, Greenley Library 206, by Noon on Friday, December 19th, 2025. It will be returned.
- Any individual may submit a nomination; self-nominations will be accepted.
- The nominator should determine that the nominee agrees to be nominated prior to submitting the nomination form.

Evaluation Criteria:

- Originality of research

- Professional recognition of the publication
- Significance of the work to the field of study
- Clarity of expression
