Walk-through of Autochartist's new Research Portal - Script

This is a high-level platform walk-through of Autochartist's new Research Portal.

This portal aims to provide almost any style of trader with simple-to-understand, actionable, and unbiased market information.

The "**Technical Analysis**" page contains what is generally considered to be the most sophisticated technical chart pattern screener available. We scan global markets for technical setups such as head-and-shoulders, triangles, wedges, horizontal support/resistance levels, and even the most sophisticated Fibonacci patterns such as 3-drive and Butterfly patterns.

If you're overwhelmed by the sheer number of technical setups, look no further than "**Our Favorites**", a filtered stream of technical setups based on historical performance statistics.

If you're interested in learning more about the stats underlying these setups, have a look at the "Performance Statistics" page, which contains the number of trade setups that hit their target in the last 12 months.

These "Our favourite" trade setups are also available on your mobile app through Auochartist's **mobile application**. Download the app from your favourite app store, and use the QR code to connect.

Tired of logging into websites to get the info you need? The "Messaging and Alerts" page allows you to set up email notifications with market updates. Emails include daily market snapshots called *Market Reports*, and arguably our most valuable product called "*Correlating Alerts*", which signals you when two or more technical setups align on an instrument.

If you're using Meta-Trader as a platform, you can download the meta-trader plugin from the "MT4/5" section of the research portal. This page also includes some tutorials about how to use the plugin.

Experienced traders know that timing a market entry is not the only important thing. Risk management is arguably an even more important aspect of trading. Autochartist offers two risk management tools. The first is "**Volatility Analysis**", which provides the expected trading range of all instruments for the next one hour, four hours and

twenty-four hours. It also allows traders to educate themselves about the dynamics of different instruments at different times of the day.

The second risk management tool we offer is the "**Risk Calculator**", which is especially useful for leveraged products such as Forex and CFDs - it allows a trader to manage risk through appropriate position sizing.

If you trade **Economic Events** such as interest rate decisions and unemployment figures, then The Economic Event Analysis section of the research portal is probably the most valuable tool you'll ever find. It shows you the upcoming high-impact events and the instruments that will be affected, and if you really like to dig in, it shows you the probabilities of the movements and how they were derived.

Of course, if you're looking for just a simple calendar, the Research portal has that too. Just click on the "Calendar" section. But notice how the high-impact events have an "analysis" button that gives you details of trade opportunities.

If you're a sentiment trader, then have a look at the "**Social Sentiment**" part of the research portal. It lists the social sentiment across major assets, allowing you to trade according to what the public feels about those brands.

And finally, the "education" section contains some educational videos about some of our products.
