

7 Continents Cup – Official Rulebook (Beta Season 2025)

Hosted by Halcyon

1. Overview

The 7 Continents Cup is a mixed, team-based competition hosted by Halcyon. This event brings together players from around the world, featuring maps from regional tournaments across all seven continents. The beta season will feature a single map from each continent, with difficulty varying from easy to challenging.

2. Dates & Times

All dates and times are listed in Eastern Standard Time (EST).

3. Qualifiers

- Each team must assign two players to Server A and two players to Server B.
- 8 rounds per session with weights of 25%, 21%, 18%, 14%, 11%, 7%, 4%, 0%.

- Your Best Round Time in the qualifier will count for 25% of your qualifying score, 2nd Best Time will be 21% and so on.
- All 4 players will count towards the qualifying.
- There will be 2 servers, both will be online on Sunday, November 9, 2025 12:00 PM and 12:45 PM
- Send one player to each server per time slot.
- DNFs are valued at 80 seconds.
- Finish timeout is set at 30 seconds.

4. Mappack

- A total of seven maps will be used, each from a different continent.
- No maps will be reused during the competition.
- Map Distribution:
 - 1 map for Qualifiers (A)
 - 2 maps for Week 1 (B & C)
 - 2 maps for Week 2 (D & E)
 - 2 maps for Playoffs (F & G)
- Release Schedule:
 - Maps A–C released one week before the event.
 - Maps D–G released after Week 1 matches.

5. League Structure

- Each division will consist of 5 teams, subject to change based on total signups.
- During the Beta Season, there will be no promotion or relegation between leagues.
- Official Season 1 (2026) will introduce promotion and relegation based on feedback.

6. League Format

- Two maps will be played per week.
- Each map will feature a 3v3 game format.
- The first team to reach 7 points wins the map.
- Point distribution: 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1.
- A 'Golden Point' is awarded based on round differential.
- Matches ending in a 2–2 draw remain as draws for league play.

7. Team Structure

- Team size: 4–8 players.
- Any player may participate in matches.
- The team captain is responsible for completing the registration form.
- Player 1 in the form will serve as captain; Player 2 as sub-captain.

8. Playoffs

- The playoff format mirrors the regular season structure.
- The top 4 teams (from each division) advance to the playoffs; bottom 1 are eliminated.
- The top 1 teams (from each division) will be able to choose who they face first in the playoffs.
- Playoffs are single elimination for the Beta Season.
- Double elimination will be introduced in Season 1.

9. Tiebreaker Rules

For qualification to playoffs:

1. Head-to-head record
2. Round differential
3. Best qualifying performance
4. Alphabetical order of team name

For playoff tiebreaks:

- Teams will play the 2nd map for the week in a first-to-3 format to determine the winner.

10. Match Organization

- Captains, co-captains, and managers will be added to a captains' chat.
- Captains are responsible for scheduling matches with opponents after qualifiers.
- No dedicated match channels will be created.

11. Match Server Settings

- Game Mode: Teams
- Point Distribution: 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1
- Point Limit: First to 7
- Finish Timeout: 20 seconds

12. Admin Rights

- Tournament Organizers and Admin Team reserves the right to make any decision they see fitting for the tournament.
