

TDSB Google Takeout/Transfer Instructions

You can copy and transfer your files from your TDSB Google Account to a personal Google Account or export the files to your computer or another online storage service. This process lets you:

- Backup your files from time to time
- Keep important files when you graduate, switch schools, or leave for another reason

There are 2 options that you can use choose from;

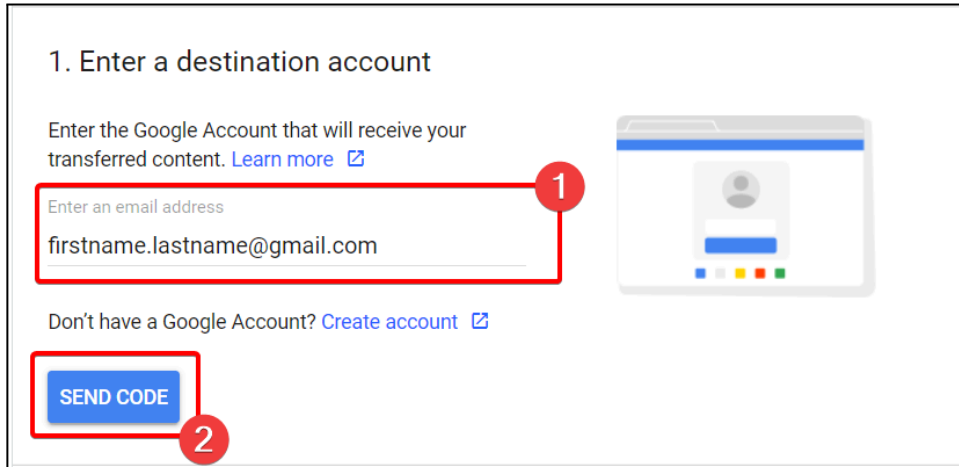
- **Transfer your data** - If you have a personal Google Account, you can transfer all of your data from your TDSB account to your personal account
- **Export your data** - if you do not have a personal Google Account, you can generate a download link or have your data transferred to another online storage service such as Dropbox, Microsoft OneDrive, or Box

Here are some things to consider before you start:

- **Download/Transfer Takes Time:** Depending how much data you have in your Google account, creating and downloading the archive account may take hours or days. Please do this at home.
- **Transferring:** All of their content may not fit into their personal Google account as TDSB Google Accounts have unlimited storage and personal Gmail accounts have a 15GB limit
- **Downloading:** This option will download your files to a single archive file (a ZIP file). Once the archive file has been created, you can download the archive file to your computer. You can then open the archive file to use your files with other programs. Downloading your data should happen on a computer that you own.

Transfer Your Data

1. Go to <https://takeout.google.com/transfer> and sign in with your TDSB Google Account
2. In the “Enter a destination account” section, **enter your personal Google email address** and click on **SEND CODE**. Do not close this window.

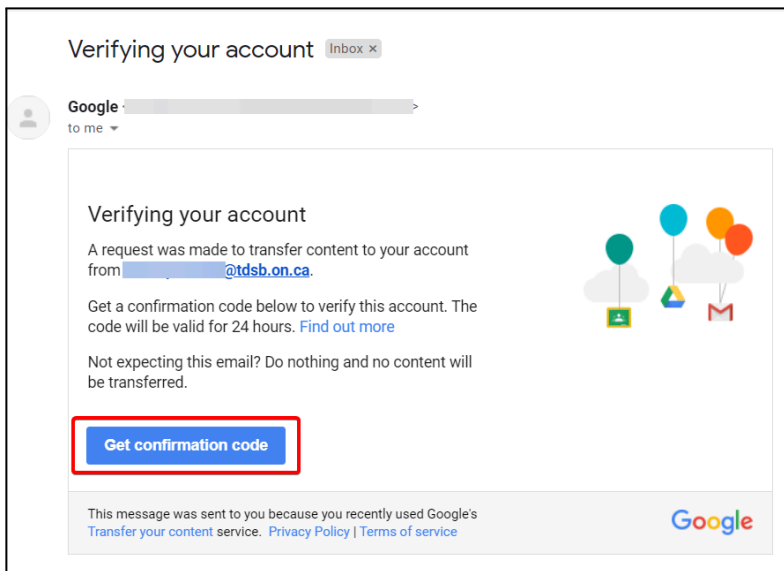

3. In a new window or tab, check your **personal email**. You will receive an email from Google with the subject “Verifying your account”. Open it and click on the **Get confirmation code** button.

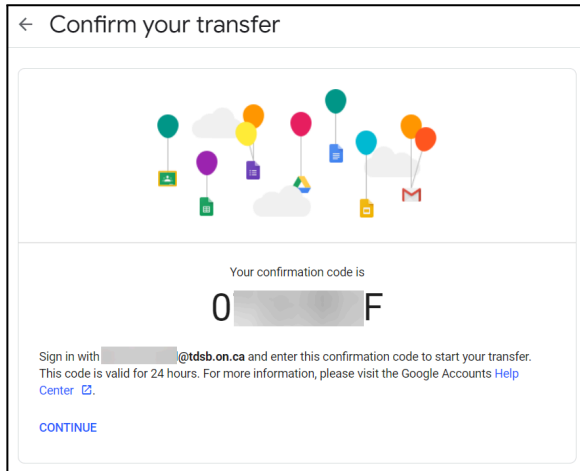

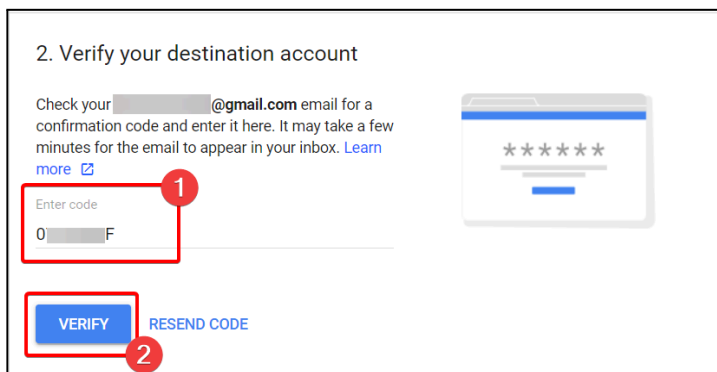

6. Select all available data to transfer, then click **START TRANSFER**.

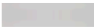
3. Select content to copy and transfer

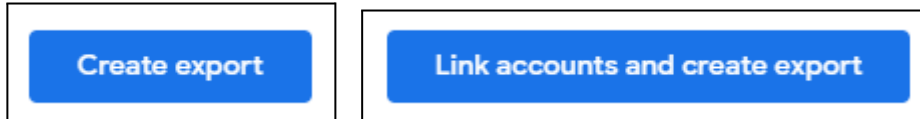
