Student Free Dress Policy

Student Uniform Policy 25-26		
The school shares in the responsibilities of student dress code and appearance with the parent/legal guardian and the individual student in the area of health, safety, and cleanliness of person and apparel. If there is a question as to whether or not any student's apparel or appearance is appropriate for school, the school administration will decide. Please view the Visual Guide to the Student Uniform Policy available on our website for further clarification.		
Article	Color	Guidelines
Polo Shirts	Navy (accepted at all Pinecrests), Red, White, Black, or Gray	Must be purchased from the uniform vendor and logoed. May not be altered or customized. May wear a solid navy, red, white, black, or gray long-sleeved T-shirt under a logoed polo shirt.
Pants Shorts Skirts Jumpers	Navy (accepted at all Pinecrests), Tan (accepted at all Pinecrests), Black	Only slacks are acceptable for uniform pants. All pants must be secured at waist level. Gapping is strictly prohibited. Shorts and skirts must be at least fingertip length while standing and walking and may not be cut-offs. Jumpers must be monogrammed and purchased from the vendor. All bottoms must be free from holes/rips and fraying. Not acceptable: Form-fitting, skinny cut, cargo, denim material, pocket/decorative zippers, tight/gathered ankles, and denim-style pockets (where the u-shaped stitching around the pocket is visible). <i>It is highly recommended that uniform pants be purchased through the uniform vendor, as these are the acceptable styles.</i>
Socks	No preference if worn below calf	If worn above the bottom of calf muscle, refer to leggings and tights guidelines. Matching socks are required if visible.
Leggings Tights	Solid Navy (accepted at all Pinecrests), Red, White, or Black	May be worn under skirts, shorts, or jumpers. Must be free from holes/rips. May not be worn as pants.
Shoes	No preference in color	Closed-toe shoes with soles and backs that are appropriate for playground use are required. High heels, house slippers, Heelys, and shoes with pivoting heel straps (e.g. Crocs) are not permitted. Matching shoes are required.
Jackets Cardigans Sweaters	Navy (accepted at all Pinecrests), Red and Black	Must be purchased at the uniform vendor and logoed to be worn inside the buildings. A uniform shirt must be worn under hoodies and jackets at all times on campus. May not be altered or customized.
Hoodies	Pinecrest Cadence Hoodies	A uniform shirt must be worn under hoodies and jackets at all times on campus. Students are required to remove their hood from their head prior to entering the building. May not be altered or customized.
Outerwear	No preference if worn outside the buildings	Coats, sweatshirts, sweaters, hoodies, etc that do not adhere to the policy may ONLY be worn outdoors and must be removed prior to entering the building. Only school appropriate graphics are permissible on campus.
PE Shirts	Navy, Red, Gray, or Black	Pinecrest Athletics T-shirts purchased from the uniform vendor.
PE Shorts PE Pants	Navy (accepted at all Pinecrests), Red, or Black	All PE bottoms must be purchased from the uniform vendor and logoed. Shorts must be fingertip length or longer when standing and walking.

To be followed on designated free dress days and by dual enrollment students.		
The school shares in the responsibilities of student dress code and appearance with the parent/legal guardians and the individual student in the area of health, safety, and cleanliness of person and apparel. If there is a question as to whether or not any student's apparel or appearance is appropriate for school, school administration will decide.		
Article	Guidelines	
All Clothing	Clothing must cover/conceal all undergarments. Slogans or advertising on clothing or accessories which by their controversial, suggestive, inappropriate, discriminatory, illegal, violent, profane, and/or obscene nature disrupt the educational setting are prohibited. Spiked or studded clothing, jewelry, and/or accessories are prohibited. Pajamas may not be worn to school (unless there is a designated pajama dress-up day). Students shall be required to show proper attention to personal cleanliness.	
Shirts/Tops	Prohibited shirts include, but are not limited to: crop tops, tank tops, muscle shirts, halter tops, strapless tops, see-through tops, low-cut tops, tops with slits, or tops that provide minimum coverage. Sleeveless blouses or dresses must be 4-fingers wide on the shoulder. Shirts/tops may not fall more than 1" below the underwear. No skin will show between bottom of shirt/blouse and top of pants or skirts/shorts at any time.	
Pants Shorts Skirts	All bottoms must be secured at waist level; sagging is strictly prohibited. Shorts, skirts, and dresses must be at least fingertip length while standing and walking. All bottoms must be free from rips, tears, holes, or frayed bottoms/edges and may not be cut-offs. Leggings (including jeggings) may not be worn as pants. Tights, leggings, or other types of hosiery must be accompanied by fingertip length or longer skirts, shorts, or dresses. Faint and other netted tights are not permitted.	
Shoes	Closed-toe shoes with soles are required. High heels, house slippers, Heelys, and shoes with pivoting heel straps (e.g. Crocs) are not permitted. Matching shoes and socks are required.	
Hair	Unnatural hairstyles and hair accessories should not exceed 3 inches from the head. Grooming accessories, such as curlers, combs, picks, durags, and wave caps, are not permitted. Excessive hair accessories are not permitted.	
Piercings	Small, discrete facial jewelry must be used for facial piercings.	
Accessories	Headgear (hats, hoods, bandanas, headbands with animal ears, etc.) is not permitted on campus. Spiked or studded clothing, jewelry, and/or accessories are prohibited. Excessive accessories and/or costume accessories are not permitted. Slogans or advertising on clothing, jewelry, buttons, and/or accessories which by their controversial, discriminatory, profane, and/or obscene nature disrupt the educational setting, are prohibited. Gloves and mittens are not permitted to be worn inside the building. No body art made by marker, pens, etc. Blankets, pillows, stuffed animals, and plushies are not permitted on campus. When worn, face coverings must be a solid color.	
PE Attire	Students who have Physical Education, Dance, Color Guard or Weight Training classes on free dress days are expected to wear appropriate clothing for participation in class.	
Dual Enrollment	Dual Enrollment students must have their red dual enrollment lanyard worn around their neck and visible at all times while on the Pinecrest Cadence campus.
