Adaptation of Plugin Manager by TabSel for use with Magix Music Maker.

- 1/. Go to; https://www.dropbox.com/s/mm3iihdle2wxaia/PluginManager%20adaptation.zip?dl=0
- 2/. Download PluginManager adaptation.zip and extract.
- 3/. Go to pluginmanager/configs/default/cache/ and double click on VSTScanPaths.ini
- 4/. Enter the path of the folders where your vst plugins are located.

For example, my two main folders are in:

C:\Program Files (x86)\VstPlugins and G:\AAAVST Plugins so it would appear as;

C:\Program Files (x86)\VstPlugins

G:\AAAVST Plugins

and I can also add any other folders that I use like the following;

C:\VstPlugins

C:\Program Files (x86)\Steinberg\Vstplugins

- 5/. Click on File and Save, then close VSTScanPaths.ini.
- 6/. Now go back to the main Pluginmanager folder and double click on PluginManager.bat.
- 7/. Allow it to do its thing and then close.

I ignore the rest of the set up and just close any other parts that I don't need.

8/. Finally, Drag the PluginManager Folder to;

C:\ProgramData\MAGIX\Music Maker\25\MxSynth

- 9/. Whenever you add any plugins, you'll have to repeat step 6 to update PluginManager.
- 10/. Launch Magix Music Maker Free and that will then scan for the plugins.

I would recommend that you move the MMM launch panel to one side of the screen so that you can OK any error messages that you might get.

NOTE 1: it may take a minute or so before you can move the MMM launch panel.

NOTE 2: If Magix Music Maker crashes just close it with Task Manager and relaunch it.

11/. Once Magix Music Maker loads, it's ready to use.
