Required materials for all Algebra classes:

Graphing Calculator: TI 84+CE calculators are the most user friendly and the ones we will be using in class. This calculator will also be used in future math classes. Many of the features will be utilized in the AP Precalculus Class. This calculator is allowed to be used on standardized tests (PSAT, SAT, NJGPA).

There may be times that a section of a quiz or test requires a calculator that is not a graphing. A simple scientific calculator will be needed for these assessments. Most students should have one from previous years.

Students must have their own calculator.
