- 7. What makes a stellar school? Teammate? Administrator?
- 8. You have just walked out of a classroom and said "Wow! That was an amazing learning experience for Ss" What did you see?
- 9. Greatness is a moving target. How do you keep moving toward greatness?
- 10. What are you passionate about? How do you showcase your passions in your position?
- 11. How could you use social media to tell the story of your classroom?
- 12. What do you do to connect and collaborate with educators outside your system?
- 13. Beyond the mandated professional development in your school/district, what do you do to continue your growth as an educator?
- 14. Tell me about a lesson that failed and what you did next.
