WHAT IS SCA?

SCA (Showchoir Camps of America) is a weeklong camp held in Tiffin, Ohio at Heidelberg University. Students are separated into groups with a vocal clinician, choreographer, an accompanist, and counselors. In five short days, each group learns an entire show choir set that they showcase for one another on the last day of camp. Each day, campers have a breakout session where they can attend a workshop of their choosing. These workshops range from hip-hop dance classes to audition tips and tricks to show choir tricks and lifts. Each night, there are performances by Broadway actors and actresses, professional a cappella groups, clinicians, and teachers.

WHEN IS SCA?

Saturday, July 11th, 2026 - Saturday, July 18th, 2026. Below is a generic itinerary of our travels:

PART 2: CAMP AND GROUP TRAVEL

ACCENTS is the parent booster group for Horizon Choir. We help manage this trip by collecting money in monthly installments, registering students for camp, and planning the travel (hotel, busing, etc.). We charge each camper to cover the cost of the camp, hotel stay, the charter bus cost, and the luggage fee for the return flight (one bag only). *NOTE: The more kids who attend camp, the lower the cost.* The charter bus and hotel costs are divided amongst all of the students. At our SCA Parent/Student meeting (typically held in early June), we will know the final cost of camp and will announce if we are able to refund any of the money collected.

The monthly payments will be divided into monthly installments, see spreadsheet below. The first payment reserves the seat for your student. All other payments are due on the 15th of the month.

Important information about payments:

- Your student's spot will be reserved once the first payment has been received. If you decide in April to have your student join us (space permitting), you will owe payments for February, March and April immediately to reserve your student's seat.
- We (ACCENTS) make one large group payment to SCA. This allows our group to check in quickly and easily in Ohio. Please be sure to follow our instructions regarding payment since we are sending one lump sum on behalf of the group as opposed to everyone sending individual checks.
- We use a software system to track your payments (www.HorizonChoirs.ManagedMissions.com). You will receive an invitation to view your information on this website as soon as you have made your first payment and reserved your

camper's spot. This system allows you to see what you've paid and what/when you still owe. Sometimes upon your first login, you will encounter a pop-up warning. We promise the site is safe!

- Space is limited! Do not delay! The bus can only accommodate so many people. The spaces are reserved on a first come, first serve basis.
- If your student is a current HHS student, they have opportunities to fundraise money throughout the year. They can also audition for an Honors Concert Scholarship to apply towards SCA (Freshman-Juniors).
- All payments will be made through a wufoo link (payable with a credit or debit card).
- Once we have registered for camp (approximately late March), a portion of any payment made will be non-refundable.



Is this a school approved field trip?

No, this is not a school field trip. Mrs. Kluch has agreed to accompany our children to and from camp. Once our kids are checked in at camp, SCA is in charge of the campers. ACCENTS assists with planning the trip, coordinating the hotel and bus, but this is NOT a school related field trip.

Can I use AZ tax credits to assist with paying for the trip?

No. Unfortunately, since this is not a school approved field trip, you are unable to use tax credit money.

Why do you travel the day before? Can't we save money by avoiding the hotel costs traveling on Sunday?

We travel the day before because we gain three hours going to Ohio. With many of our talented students choosing to audition for the dance ensemble, jazz ensemble, and talent show, we would not arrive at camp early enough to allow them to do so if we traveled on Sunday.

Who will my student room with in the hotel? Who will my student room with at camp?

While traveling, we have the kids in double beds, four to a room. We try our best to accommodate roommate requests but cannot guarantee them. Once we have a complete roster of all students attending, we will send a list out so that kids can request roommates.

At camp, the kids are in twin beds, two to a dorm room. On the SCA form, there is a place to write-in a roommate request. Typically SCA groups kids loosely by grade (middle school, high school, graduated seniors). Please keep this in mind when picking your roommate.

How much extra money will my student need?

Plan on approximately \$60-\$80 for the few meals not covered at camp (mostly travel day meals). \$40 for luggage (return flight only) If you allow your student to purchase souvenirs from camp, the t-shirts and sweatshirts sold range in cost from \$12-\$35.

Who can attend SCA?

All students entering 7th grade through graduated seniors are eligible to attend SCA. We have had students from neighboring schools attend, plus students from Desert Shadows Middle School choirs, Decibels, Low Frequency, Noteworthy, Show Divas, Towne Criers and Step on Stage. All are welcome to join us!
