- **DEADLINE** for course selection is **February 11, 2022**
- February 7th-11th -Families can check Parent Portal for course request review and communicate errors to the student's current counselor.
- Students who want to change to a lower level course may request the change during the 4th - 6th weeks of school OR at change of semester. Requesting a level change does not guarantee a change can be made.

ADVANCED COURSES: PISD policy requires students to remain enrolled in advanced courses for 3 weeks before a drop in levels will be considered. Honors and AP grade points are not awarded unless a student completes a full semester in that course.

Be careful and avoid overloading your schedule with too many advanced courses. Balance your academics, activities, family and social obligations.
