• Thank YOU for instilling a love of music in the hearts and minds of your students. As Martin Luther said, "Next to the Word of God, music deserves the highest praise. The gift of language combined with the gift of song was given to man that he should proclaim the Word of God through Music."

Using a Children's Choir in Worship

- A balance of a liturgical vs. anthem-only choir (whether children or adults) should constantly be on the mind of the director. The choir "anthem" does not always need to be in addition to the service, find a way for the choir "anthem" to fit within the service -- pay attention to the readings, themes, etc. for a given Sunday.
- Do you also direct the adult choir at your congregation? If so, schedule a few singing dates throughout the year when your choirs sing **together**. If you're not the director, consider approaching your adult choir director with this idea.
