

Star Wars Galaxy: History

75 years ago over the Sith homeworld of Exegol the Resistance overcame the First and Final Orders in a heroic battle that ended in the destruction of the infamous Sith Lord Emperor Palpatine. With the heart of the First Order gone, its remaining members split up much like with the Empire into remnants that were scattered around the galaxy.

The reestablished New Republic took the next five years to hunt down and destroy these remnants. The last known First Order Remnant faction was destroyed in 40 ABY over Pillio beginning what would be later be known as the 54 Years of Peace. This new era was one of, as the name suggests, peace. No conflict happened during this time and the New Republic grew to become a powerful government once again with Rey Skywalker taking charge as the new Chancellor and Grand Master of a new Jedi Order.

This whole movement, however, was squashed in 94 ABY at the end of the 54 Years of Peace when a great surprise entered the galaxy. Long ago the Rakatans had ruled the galaxy, but they had been thought to have been wiped out.

Unfortunately, they were not, and what survived from the plague that had been assumed to have destroyed their species had returned to take back what was theirs. This time they had the advantage. After 25,000 years of waiting and rebuilding, the New Infinite Empire had the biggest fleet the galaxy had ever seen.

Not only that, but they had used that time to rebuild their Star Forge bigger and better than ever before this time with extra weapons stolen off the wrecks of superweapons like the Galaxy Gun and Death Star. With this new Star Forge, the Infinite Empire was able to replenish their fleets easily and conquered the New Republic almost overnight to establish their rule over the galaxy.

As the Rakatans began to expand, however, people started to rise up and fight them, but none of these movements were as influential as in 99 ABY, 5 years after the beginning of the Rakatan's rule, when the Rakatans put in place a large tax that drove powerful factions such as the Mandalorians to rebel.

The tax was quickly lifted to avoid further troubles, but when the Mandalorians refused to stand down, the New Infinite

Empire had their Mand'alor assassinated. The Mand'alor's son was then forced into the role at a much younger age than he had been expected to and had to lead the Mandalorians against the Rakatans to get revenge. This resistance sprung up more allies and enemies to the Infinite Empire and a war broke out.

In 100 ABY one of the most influential rebel cells known as the Union of Freedom became one of the first targets of the Infinite Empire's new battle station. It was forced to rebuild from almost nothing, but its near destruction led them to seek help from larger cells such as the mighty Mandalorians and the very rich faction called ProtoTECH.

The alliance with the Mandalorians was soon broken, but the Union of Freedom joined with other cells to form the Galactic Defender Alliance. This new alliance, however, was betrayed by one of its own members. The location of their secret base was sold to the New Infinite Empire, which took this opportunity to destroy that resistance cell once and for all, but its destruction only caused more problems for the Rakatans. The destruction of the Galactic Defender Alliance resulted in a much more urgent need to destroy the Rakatans' battle station.

A small group of rebels went undercover to the Rakatan's capital to retrieve the superweapon's plans. They were able to discover how to destroy it, but their attempts to do so were thwarted by the Infinite Empire, whom trapped them on the planet of Dantooine below the station in an attempt to force them to surrender, but it did not work.

A mysterious faction, which had heard of the events occurring around Dantooine took over the job of destroying the station efficiently before retreating back into the shadows. With the destruction of the Infinite Empire's most powerful asset, like the empires before them, they began to crumble, finally being destroyed in their own attack over Mandalore by the Mandalorians in 101 ABY after being fooled by one of many devious plans of the faction Bloodhound to take control of the galaxy. At last the galaxy was free. Well, that is at least what everyone had thought.

Of course, with the loss of the government keeping the order, order was completely lost. The galaxy was thrown into chaos and by the end of 101 ABY a new criminal faction had risen more powerful than any other during this era of disorder. The Dark Dawn, led by a supposedly resurrected

Darth Maul, began wreaking havoc all over the galaxy and freeing deadly criminals to fuel their armies.

Soon war broke out against the Dark Dawn. With the Bounty Hunter's Guild taking the lead against the new criminal organization, the battles begun, costing both sides much trouble, but in the end Maul was captured, and the threat of the Dark Dawn seemingly diminished to none, but the one who was really in charge of it all behind the scenes was not done yet.

The temporary defeat of the Dark Dawn allowed large factions to correct their mistakes by establishing order in the galaxy once again under empires and republics. The galaxy, however, was still divided amongst the factions.

Later in 103 ABY more and more impossible sightings of ancient Sith were recorded, and across the galaxy fear was on the rise again. Somehow the Sith Lord Darth Plagueis had returned and was trying to assemble a rebellion against the whole galaxy to prevent tyranny. Not only this, but on the planet of Nirauan, the Sith Triumvirate was discovered causing problems.

Yet again something had to be done about this threat, and yet again the Bounty Hunter's Guild was the one to pull it off with the help of some newer Sith and Jedi, who were willing to work together to defeat the Sith Triumvirate, and they nearly won.

By some miracle the Over'Predor, who had once led the New Infinite Empire, had survived. At the last moment he came in and rescued all the Sith except for Traya, whom he left. As it turned out, the Over'Predor had actually resurrected the Sith himself after perfecting a ritual Palpatine had nearly gotten right before his unfortunate death, but he didn't stop at the Sith Triumvirate.

The Over'Predor planned to rebuild his empire, but he was growing too old and weak to do such a thing, so the true purpose for why he had recreated the Sith was to undergo a ritual of essence transfer on a clone of Palpatine he had made for this moment to give himself a new body.

Finally, after being resurrected as Palpatine, the Over'Predor lures the rest of the Sith he had made to the planet of Exegol where he did the same ritual Darth Vitiate had done thousands of years before, making him, the Over'Predor, the most powerful being in the galaxy.

Now Vigo Kua, who once was known as the Over'Predor, set in motion the plan to retake the galaxy. He took over Kamino to help him grow a clone army more advanced than the one made for the Republic over a century before, and he had his own shipyards started to produce ships for his fleet that all began to assemble at Kamino. This new force that would soon torment the galaxy was the start of the Sith Republic

At last in 110 ABY the armies of the Sith Republic are ready. With Vigo Kua leading them into battle, the millions of newly grown Sith Troopers now charge full speed ahead into the rest of the galaxy, ready at last to show their face and plow through anyone who opposes them.

As all of this is happening, on the outer rim planet of Jabiim, which many years ago had been ravaged by a deadly battle between the Republic and the Separatists, another faction is rising from ruins to power in the galaxy.

Using old parts left over from the Clone Wars on the planet of Jabiim and other places around the galaxy, the Alliance of Independent Dominions or AID is able to grow their military but also help restore planets in the outer rim to what they could be.

Under the leadership of Jedi Master Caiaphas, the Alliance was able to flourish on Jabiim and across other worlds around it all the way through the reign of the New Infinite Empire, but on the other side of that conflict they were faced with greater difficulties.

Being in such close proximity to Kamino in 110 ABY as the Sith Republic came into the light became a large problem for the Alliance of Independent Dominions, but they did not view others that way. They were the first ones to resist the Sith Republic's rule and started another galactic civil war against them to stop their expansion from becoming a threat to the people of the galaxy.

Across the galaxy factions are forced to pick a side of this new galaxy sized fight or get caught in the middle. The Alliance of Independent Dominions and everyone else willing to stand and fight are all that stands between this new threat and its complete control over the entire galaxy now.
