The Village 2026 – FAQ



What is The Village?

The Village is a by-application-only experience curated for founders, funders, creatives, and community builders. It's a space for **rest**, **reflection**, **skill-sharing**, **and intentional connection**. Each gathering includes a mix of curated workshops, co-created moments, and down time—with the goal of building a regenerative ecosystem of support.

Where and when is it?

We're offering two sessions in 2026:

- January 5-10, 2026 Roda de Barà, Spain (just outside Barcelona, near the beach)
- June dates TBA Massaguel, France (a lush countryside village 1.5 hours from Toulouse)

Who is it for?

The Village is for mission-driven humans building or backing something meaningful. Attendees include:

- Founders & entrepreneurs
- · Artists, facilitators, and storytellers
- Healers, strategists, and cultural workers
- Investors & funders with a community-first mindset

All genders are welcome. The experience is intentionally designed for reflection, sharing, and stillness—alongside moments of creativity and joy.

How do I attend?

You must be a **Sengo member** to attend The Village.

If you haven't joined yet, you can become a member here at the tier that fits you best (**Founder**, **Funder**, or **All Access**).

If the tier you need isn't currently open, you can join the waitlist and we'll notify you when space is available.

What does it cost?

Roda de Barà (January – Spain):

- Shared Bed Room (2-person) \$700 per person
 - Private room with king bed (must apply + book together)
- Full Price Individual \$1,500
 - o Private room with double bed
- Contributors \$350
 - Shared room with a single bed

Massaguel (June – France):

- Full Price Individual \$1,500
- Room types vary; even full-price attendees may be assigned a single bed
- **Contributors** \$350
 - Shared room with single bed

All accepted contributors pay \$350 upon confirmation.

What are the room options like?

- In **Spain**, full-price attendees receive a **private room** with a **double bed**. Shared-bed bookings (for two applicants) also receive a **private room**.
- In **France**, rooms are a mix of shared and private accommodations. You may be placed in a **shared room** with a single bed, even as a paid attendee.
- Contributor applicants are typically assigned single beds in shared rooms.

X Is travel included?

No-airfare is not included.

We provide ground transportation from nearby train stations on arrival and departure days:

- Massaguel (France):
 - We recommend flying into Toulouse. If you fly into Paris, you may travel 6hr by train to Toulouse, or book a short flight.
 - Arrive into **Toulouse**, then take a train to **Castres**.
 - Your train to Castres must arrive before 8:00 PM—we cannot provide late-night shuttles.
 - A free group shuttle from Castres to the house in Massaguel will be provided.
- Roda de Barà (Spain):
 - Fly into Barcelona.
 - Shuttle logistics are being finalized and will be shared closer to the retreat date.

- Lodging for 5 nights
- Group meals and snacks provided by our private chef
- Full access to all community-led workshops, healing sessions, and creative activations
- Wine provided for the duration of the trip
- There may be up to two (2) unprovided lunch meals

What does a contributor do?

Contributors help co-create the experience by offering a session, practice, or moment for the group. Examples include:

- A workshop or talk
- A movement, mindfulness, or creative session
- A facilitated conversation

A ritual, game, or community moment

We aim to curate a diverse blend of personal, professional, and playful offerings.



👫 Can I bring a friend or partner?

Sure! But each reservation or application is individual. If you're attending with someone, both people must reserve or apply and indicate each other's names.



👶 Can I bring my child?

We love that The Village attracts caregivers and community-minded parents. Subject to demand, we are working on a way to accommodate children.

Is this a women's retreat?

No. The Village is open to all genders. It is intentionally inclusive and designed for those who value integrity, generosity, creativity, and care.

What's the cancellation/refund policy?

- Contributor deposits (\$350) are non-refundable after 30 days
- Paid guests may cancel up to **90 days before** the retreat for a refund.
- After that window, you may transfer your spot to someone else or request to defer to a future retreat (pending availability)
