

TAKE ACTION: Support MONICA Montgomery Steppe For San Diego City Council President

On Thursday, December 10th, 2020, the new San Diego City Council will cast their first vote to determine who will be the City Council President. Only **Monica Montgomery Steppe** has the integrity, experience and track record to lead the City Council, find common ground, move our city forward. Visit our website, https://monica4prez.org.

RESULT: In a 5-4 vote, the council voted for Jennifer Cambell to be the Council President. They did not discuss the issue or explain their votes.

Use this toolkit to take these three actions:

- 1) Email all of the councilmembers
- 2) Call into the Council meeting on Dec 10 and provide public comment
- 3) Share information and actions with your network



1. Email the Councilmembers

Use <u>the email generator on our website</u> to email all 9 councilmembers and councilmembers elect and let them know why you support Monica Montgomery Steppe to be the next Council President. We include a draft email, but encourage you to use your own story and words. Talking points below. You can also email the councilmembers directly using the email addresses <u>on our website</u>.



2. Call into the Council Meeting on Dec 10

WHEN: 2 pm on Thursday, December 10

HOW TO CALL IN:

- 1. Tune in to the <u>livestream</u> at 2pm. Click "Watch City TV Live Feed" on the right side of the screen.
- 2. When the **Agenda Item 201** (the ONLY agenda item for this meeting) comes up, **DIAL 619-541-6310** and Enter the Access Code **877861#**. If you don't get through at first, keep trying.
- 3. You will hear a recording state "you have now been placed in the queue." Wait quietly until you hear your name and "you have been unmuted". This will be your opportunity to speak.

TIPS:

- TONE:
 - We encourage everyone to use positive statements that focus on why we support Monica and keep a calm tone. Uplift Monica's qualifications, experience, skills, leadership, values.
 - Do not demonize or personally attack anyone. If you discuss any problems with Jen's experience or leadership only do that if you are speaking from personal experience focused on how her actions are not in line with good governance.
- There is only this issue on the agenda, so they should start taking public comment quickly. We don't know how long the meeting will last depends on how many people call in.
- You will have one minute to speak (maximum 100 words). Make sure to state your name, neighborhood. Speak slowly and clearly. Pick 1-2 talking points you are passionate about don't try to cover it all. Include a personal experience if possible.

 in our communities.
