



Chinese NCEA Level 1

Course Description:

This course is open to students wishing to gain NCEA credits in Chinese. You will gain skills in: Listening; Speaking; Reading Pinyin and Chinese Characters; and Writing Pinyin and Chinese Characters. The learning will broaden your understanding of Chinese history and culture. There will be opportunities to take 2 internal assessment standards and 2 external achievement standards **offering 20 credits**.

- Building knowledge on how Chinese is linguistically and socially organised
- Gain valuable cultural knowledge
