## **CHARACTERS:**

- Jack Kelly: a fiercely loyal and charismatic orphan who dreams of a life out west and boldly leads the Manhattan newsies.
- Les: Davey's cheeky younger sibling who is inspired by the freedom of the newsies and loves their independent lifestyle.
- Crutchie: Jack Kelly's ever-optimistic best friend and fellow newsie; walks with the aid of a wooden crutch.
- Davey: Les' straight-laced, bright older brother who acts as the brains behind the newsies strike.
- Katherine Plumber: an ambitious young reporter who works hard to make a name for herself; courageously uses her voice to cover the newsies' strike.
- Medda Larkin: a big-voiced saloon singer and star of the Bowery who
  offers her teacher as a safe haven for the newsies.
- Wiesel: a disgruntled manager of distribution for the World, often called "Weasel" by the newsies.
- Joseph Pulitzer: a pompous businessman and Katherine's no-nonsense father; does not sympathize with the strikers, but comes to respect Jack.
- Bunsen: Pulitzer's bookkeeper, helps come up with the idea to raise the newsies' price per page.
- Hannah: Pulitzer's secretary, who disagrees with his plan to raise the price of papers.
- Pat: the stage manager of Medda's theater.
- Snyder: the crooked and sinister warden of The Refuge.
- **Seitz**: an editor who advises Pulitzer, but ultimately admires the kids' newspaper.
- Dorthy & Bill: Katherine's friends, whose parents own the New York Tribune and New York Journal, respectively, help the newsies print the Newsies Banner.

- Oscar & Morris Delancey: toughs who work for the New York World; known to use their fists to make a point.
- **Spot Conlon**: the proud leader of the Brooklyn newsies with an intimidating reputation.
