



# Entrelac Lace Babbling Brook Pillow

## Materials Needed:

- Bulky weight yarn, 8 oz
- Size 9 needles or size needed to get gauge
- 16 – 18 Inch pillow form (16 for a loose fit, 18 for a tight fit)
- Tapestry needle

Gauge: 3 sts/inch in garter

Note: This particular pattern is a multiple of 11 sts. To choose another lace, multiply by the number of stitches in the pattern and add 2 stitches to each repeat. You need a solid stitch on each end of each row for the picking up rows. Do a gauge swatch to see how many repeats you will need to get to your particular finished size. For pillows, wear seems to be universally hard on the edges, thus the garter triangles.

Abbreviations Used: WS = Wrong Side, RS = Right Side, SSK = Slip, Slip, Knit 2 together thru the back loop, RHCT = Right Hand Corner Triangle, RSR = Right Side Rectangle, KFB = Knit in the front and back of the indicated stitch, LHCT = Left Hand Corner Triangle, k2tog = knit 2 together, p2tog = purl 2 together, WSR = Wrong Side Rectangle, ET = End Triangles



Cast on 33 sts.

Row 1 Base Triangles:

- R1: (WS): k2, turn
- R2: (RS): k2, turn
- R3 & 4: k3, turn
- R5 & 6: k4, turn
- R7 & 8: k5, turn
- R9 & 10: k6, turn

Continue in this manner adding one more stitch every other row until last WS, k11, has been worked.

Rep from \* until 3 triangles have been worked.

Row 2: Right Hand Corner Triangle

- R1: (RS): K2, turn
- R2: k2, turn
- R3: kfb, ssk (2<sup>nd</sup> st of this triangle and 1<sup>st</sup> st of the prev triangle/rectangle worked), turn
- R4: k3, turn
- R5: kfb, k1, ssk (see above explanation)
- R6: k4, turn
- R7: kfb, k2, ssk
- R8: k5, turn
- Continue in this manner until last RS row (Kfb, k9, ssk) has been worked. DO NOT TURN. RHCT is complete. Leave stitches on needle and continue with RSR.

Right Side Rectangle (RSR)

Pick up Row: (RS) Pick up and k 11 sts evenly along the edge of the next triangle or rectangle. Turn.

- R1: (WS) P1, k1, p3, k1, p3, k1, p1, turn.
- R2: K1, (p1, k3, yo) twice, p1, ssk. Turn.
- R3: P1, k1, p4, k1, p4, k1, p1. Turn
- R4: K1, (p1, k1, k2tog, yo, k1) twice p1, ssk. Turn.
- R5: Rep R3 of RSR
- R6: k1, (p1, k2tog, yo, k2) twice, p1, ssk. Turn.
- R7: p1, (k1, p2tog, p2) twice k1, p1. Turn.
- R8: K1, (k2tog, yo, k2) twice, p1, ssk. Turn.
- Rep R1 – 8 Then R1 – 5
- Next row: k1, (p1, k2tog, k2) twice, p1, ssk.
- Rep RSR.

Left Hand Corner Triangle

- Pick up and k 11 along edge of last triangle or rectangle. Turn.
- R1: (WS) k2tog, k9. Turn.
- R2: k10. Turn
- R3: k2tog, k8. Turn.
- R4: k9. Turn.
- Continue in this manner until last RS row k2, turn has been worked. K2tog. DO NOT TURN.

Row 3: Wrong Side Rectangle

- Pick up and p 10 sts along edge of triangle or rectangle just worked. Turn. 11 sts.
- R1: (RS) K1, (p1, k3, yo) twice, p1, k1. Turn.
- R2: p1, (k1, p4) twice, k1, p2tog. Turn
- R3: k1, (p1, k1, k2tog, yo, k1) twice, p1, k1. Turn.
- R4: Rep R2 of WSR
- R5: k1, (p1, k2tog, yo, k2) twice, p1, k1. Turn.
- R6: P1, (k1, p2tog, p2) twice, k1, p2tog. Turn.
- R7: k1, (k2tog, yo, k2) twice, p1, k1. Turn.
- R8: p1, (k1, p3) twice, k1, p2tog. Turn.
- Rep R1 – 8 then R1 – 6.

Continue by repeating Row 2 (RHCT, RSR, LHCT) and Row 3 (WSR), then Row 2 (RHCT, RSR, LHCT) again. Proceed with Row 4 ET. Fasten Off. Repeat or for a plain back, Cast on 33 sts and Knit 16" in stockinette. Sew

#### Row 4 End Triangles

- \*Pick up row: Pick up and P 10 sts (11 total) along triangle or rectangle (as they present themselves). Turn.
- R1: (RS) P11. Turn.
- R2: p2tog, p8, p2tog (last of the 11 sts and 1<sup>st</sup> of the next side). Turn.
- R3: p10. Turn.
- R4: p2tog, p7, p2tog.
- Continue in this manner until last RS row p2tog, turn has been worked.
- Next row: p2tog, p2tog. Pass the first st over the 2<sup>nd</sup>.

Rep from \* until 3 ET have been worked. Fasten off.
