## *Expressive Features* of Art & Design

Today we are going to learn about Expressive Features of Art & Design, also known as Elements & Principles of Art. ## Task 3 – Steller Activity

Now it's time to show off all that you learned about the Elements & Principles,

### Step 1: Take/Compile Photographs

You will be compiling photographs that show examples of each of the Elements & Principles of Art. You can take these pictures around your house, and/or find photos in your existing camera roll. You will have **15 total photographs**, one for each element or principle:

### Step 2: Download Steller

*Steller* is a free smartphone app for iOS and Android. It is similar to Instagram in that you will be creating visual “stories.” However, unlike Instagram, your stories don’t disappear after 24 hours and the app is approved for DCSD. We will likely use this app again.

[Here is my example Elements & Principles story.](#) Many artists use Steller to show the process of their artwork. P.S. It features a photo of Aspen the cat!

### Step 3: Making your story.

Play around in the app and explore your options. There are many ways you can personalize your story.

1. Once you are on the app, press the “+” to create a new photo story. (This is different on Android.)
  2. Choose a photo to include (it is easier to do one at a time).
  3. Click “**Import.**”
  4. Choose a layout (there are more across the top).
  5. On that slide, label what the Element/Principle is.
  6. Press “**Done.**”
  7. Press the “+” in the bottom left corner to add another page. All of the pages should be in the same story/post.
  8. Repeat until you have all 15 photos.
  9. Want to make it look professional? Add a cover/title page.

### Step 4:

When your story is complete, click “**Preview,**” then “**Publish.**”

### Step 5: Sharing

Write your username on [this document](#) so I can find your story.

*\* Note: If you prefer for your profile to be set up as a private account, send me, @profesalz, a follow request. Then, be on the lookout for a return follow request from me. You will need to accept it so I can see your story. If this is the case, please still write your username on the document.*
