r/GenBeta and r/Gen Alpha Strike System

Whenever a user breaks a rule on these subreddits, usually one strike is incurred. However, more disruptive and inappropriate behavior (for example, LGBTQ+ phobia or racism/ableism) may give you 3-4 strikes. Strikes can be given twice for the same reason. If you are continuously making homophobic, racist, or ableist comments, you will be permanently banned from the subreddit. Learn more on the Strike Hierarchy in the **next tab**.

Strike Chronological Order:

- 1 strike: verbal warning
- 2 strikes: 1-day temporary ban
- 3 strikes: 3-day temporary ban
- 4 strikes: 1 week temporary ban
- 5 strikes: 1 month temporary ban
- 6 strikes: 1 year temporary ban
- 7 strikes: permanent ban

If you receive a ban, you may appeal through moderation mail. Note that not all appeals will be accepted.

If after a week or so moderators have noticed no disruption from a user, a strike may be lifted. So, for example, if a person has 4 strikes, meaning on their 5th strike, they would get a 1 month suspension, but suddenly behaves quite well in the subreddit, a strike would be removed, meaning the next infraction they would receive would still be a 1 week ban, not a 1 month ban.

Strike Hierarchy

Strike Hierarchy

Offenses ranked from least serious to most serious:

Advertising/Timeframe Specific/Low Quality: Post removal. Repeated offense will result in a strike.

Common sense: Based on severity, mostly o/1 strikes though.

User Respect: o/1 strike

Spam: 1/2 strikes, depending on severity

Hate Speech: 4 strikes

Age Minimum: Instant permanent ban, but if you tell birthdate then it will be shortened to until you

become 13

Community Threats: Instant permanent ban

NSFW/NSFL: Instant permanent ban

Inciting conflict: This is volatile and heavily depends on what the rule break was. If you are abusing user respect, you will receive 1 strike. Similarly, if you make any hate speech comments or posts, you will receive 3-4 strikes, and so on. Note that even if a person started the conflict, if you respond in the same manner as the instigator, you are to receive the same punishment as the instigator.

Malicious Content: This is harmful content to other users, and also based on severity.
