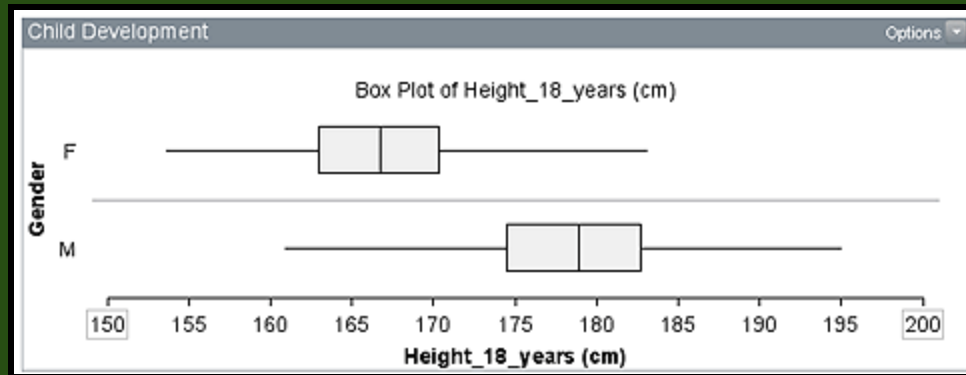


POPULATION INFERENCE

MULTIVARIATE DATA



The point of doing Multivariate Data is to answer the comparative questions you have. Once you have collected the data and created your graphs, you should be able to make some conclusions.

Remember, you are using samples to talk about the population. You use your sample to make some inferences. SAMPLES ARE NOT PERFECT.
