B A (HEP – HISTORY, ECONOMICS, POLITICAL SCIENCE)

History:

The students obtain wider knowledge of facts and figures of the past and make the learner assimilate the essence of that through multidisciplinary approach. It takes the learners into the intellectual forum through the study of history. It inculcates a sense of nationalism to enable the student community to face the onslaught of communalism and casteism.

Economics:

Students will be familiar with introductory, canonical models of consumer and producer behaviour and of macro economy have a basic understanding of the operation of a modern economy be able to evaluate the effects of government interventions in individual markets and in the macro economy. They can analyze operations of markets under varying competitive conditions. They can analyze causes and consequences of unemployment, inflation and economic growth.

Political Science:

The students understand the basic principles of Politics including governing institutions and branches, political wings and organizations, political behavior and the operation of government at both the national and state levels. Understanding government and politics in a comparative perspective and understand government and politics in a global context
