IF YOU ARE:

- A high school senior for the School Year 23/24
- Graduating high school no later than June 2024
- Eligible for a work permit
- Low income [2023 High Poverty Zip Code](#)

AND meet ONE OR MORE of the following barriers:

- Basic skills deficient
- English language learner
- Offender
- Foster care
- Homeless, runaway, or out of home placement
- Pregnant or parenting
- Individual with disability
