

Baseball Tee Ball Rules Summary

All rules not referenced in this summary follow the 2025 Little League Baseball Rulebook

Time Limit (Regular Season): Games will end after 45 minutes of playing time.

Batting Lineup: Continuous batting lineup will be used. The lineup should be rotated either each inning or each game.

Half Inning: A half inning will be complete when all batters have had a chance to hit.

Defensive Alignment: All players will play the field each inning using the standard infield positions with extra players positioned in the outfield. It is highly recommended that the defensive players are rotated after every 1-2 batters to keep even playing time and the kids moving. You may keep the same P for an entire inning. No player can play more than one inning at P in the same game. Defensive coaches are allowed to be positioned on the field during the game.

Bunting: Bunting is not allowed in Tee Ball.

Baserunning: Play will stop when an infielder raises the ball in fair territory. Runners cannot advance on overthrows. Runners should advance one base per hit ball.
