

I. Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm.

II. **Welcome and Pledge of Allegiance**

III. **Band Director's Report**

a. Band Camp

- i. The band is ahead of schedule
- ii. Marching has been picked up – extra quality that can be tweaked and tightened up to look better than they have in the past
- iii. Drum Major Auditions – best group of auditioners in a while!
- iv. Monday – played through Pre-Game
 1. Sound-wise was one of the nicest starts for camp
 2. Kids are doing a wonderful job so far.
- v. **Saturday, August 12, 2023**
 1. Two performances
 - a. Pleasant Hills Community Day Parade
 - i. TJ Band is first in the parade
 - ii. Load buses at parade and load buses to head to Kennywood
 - iii. Upperclassmen – wearing a band t-shirt from the past for parade graders – black shirt (any black shirt) for parade; new members wear a black shirt
 - b. Kennywood Parade
 - i. Uniform Options
 1. Band shoes, low cut socks, shorts, and this year's band t-shirt
 2. Uniform bottoms with shirt over top
 3. Full uniform
 - ii. 4:00 back to buses to get into the uniforms

b. **Florida Trip – April 2024**

- i. Estimated cost of \$2,200 per kid, give or take \$200
 - ii. The cost of trip was reduced by taking out Busch Gardens and putting in Sea World due to bus driving costs.
 - iii. We will get closer to an exact itinerary in the future.
 - iv. April 8 after school, the band will leave.
 1. Take a chartered flight to Orlando
 2. Unsure size of plane or how many can be accommodated
 3. There are 2 sizes for charters; will need to ss what the numbers are and will see about opening seats up for family members.
 4. The entire band, personnel, and chaperones travel together.
 - v. Thursday is Honors Band students + orchestra + choir performance at Universal.
 1. Covers orchestra and choir performances
 - vi. Friday's performance is in Magic Kingdom
 - vii. late Sunday night April 14th - come home
 1. Everyone needs to be in class on Monday, April 15th.
- c. Questions: When the kids are performing at Universal, where is the rest of the group?
- i. Everyone travels together and goes to the same places at the same times on the same days.
- d. **Football Games**
- i. There is a game before school starts – "Game Zero"
 - ii. 8/25/23 at Franklin Regional

1. Administration wanted the Band to participate in this game.
2. Thinking of doing "Summer Uniform" again at this game.

e. Auxiliary New Uniforms

- i. Color Guard and majorette uniform samples are in. There are a few things that need to be asked about.
 1. The new uniforms look very nice.
 2. Hope to get them before regular season is over. Hopefully, late October.
 3. For photos, they will wear the current uniforms.

f. Mandatory Meeting for Disney Trip

- i. There will be a mandatory meeting for all students/parents who are attending Disney trip.
 1. The itinerary will be set at this time.
 2. Once we have the itinerary, it will not be changed.
 3. Travel agent will be available to help.
 4. What you raise in funds will take your kid from TJHS on Monday until Sunday night to TJHS. They will need nothing except for money to spend on souvenirs.
 - a. If there are insufficient funds in student's GSA, you can pay with a check.
 5. Question: The Disney meeting will be in October?
 - a. Depends on when the information will be ready.

V. Treasurer's Report

- a. May 2023 – end of last year – no May 2023 meeting.
 - i. A lot of payments in May went to the Band Banquet, which we budgeted for.
 - ii. June 2023 – last month of the 2022-23 school year
 1. Did make a deposit of \$200 for Bar Bingo
 2. Everything else was Raise Right program
 - iii. July 2023 – Taylor Swift payments have been transferred to GSA
 - iv. Disney Choice Payment Deposit: \$30,000
 1. Question: Can we pay the entire Disney fee at the end of the year?
 - a. No, we have already put a big deposit down.
 - b. We have secured our spot at Disney this year.
 - c. Orchestra and Choir will give us \$20,000.
 - d. We need to make this money back.
 - v. Any questions, reach out to Kerry.
 - vi. Gator Fund: \$2,042.00
 - vii. Question: What is a gator?
 1. The gator is a side-by-side utility vehicle that tows stuff to fields
 2. It does to every game, parade, festival, etc.
 3. It is about 11 years old.
 4. Parts are hard to find. We have put some costly repairs into it.
 5. We are raising funds to purchase a new gator.
 6. The cost is about \$11K - \$15K for the type of gator we need.
 - a. WE may get \$1500-3000 for our gator to sell it.
